Subject: CACC Race Competition Regulations - Amendments

3. Licensing

3.2 A - amend to "Any person fifteen (15) years or older..." after "holds a valid provincial driver's licence" add ", or meets the requirements for 15 year olds outlined in 3.2 (B)"

3.2 B -add "Applicants who are 15 years old shall meet the following requirements:

i) Have achieved their 15th birthday. There will be no exceptions.

ii) Produce a valid karting licence issued by ASN Canada FIA or an ASN affiliated kart club

iii) Proof of competing in at least two full seasons of ASN-sanctioned kart racing

iv) Have successfully completed a CACC or ASN recognized Race Driving School

v) Have passed and submitted the normal CACC/ASN medical examination for a first time applicant

If successful, applicants may be issued a Junior CACC Race Licence which makes them eligible to compete in FF (Formula 1600), Formula V or equivalents of no greater performance or closed wheel cars under 2000cc which are normally aspirated.

Cars driven by Junior drivers shall be identified by a rearward facing sign 20 cm (8 in) in diameter with a white "J" on a red background. The sign shall be clearly visible to following vehicles.

3.6 B change "Every five (5) years for applicants 15 to 35..."

4.2 A after "all persons under 16 years old" add ", with the exception of drivers holding a CACC Junior Race Licence,"
