Meeting Minutes

David Bell chaired the meeting, instead of Neil Gustafson. Why, I don't know.

There is only one event scheduled for 2022, it will be the 50th anniversary of Ice Racing in BC. February 19 & 20, 2022. It will be wheel to wheel Racing.

Budget

- Propose to reduce license fees from \$40 down to \$25 with an anticipated license count of 10-15 which is an increase over last year at 4.
- Increase permit fee from \$30 up to \$50

Rules

- Remove the following rule completely as it is redundant. (Rule number 10 from the Preparation and Safety section is redundant to number 8)
 - KEEP 8) *A combination brake/running light mounted high on the rear of the vehicle is mandatory. An 1157/3157 or equivalent wattage bulb is required.*
 - REMOVE 10) *It mandatory that all vehicles run a high mount, rear facing, always on amber/orange light on the exterior of the vehicle*
- The GCRs specify the requirements that pertain to fire suppression systems if they are required by class regulations or installed by choice. We cannot find where it is required to have a fire extinguisher in the car. We have also looked at the Race regulations and it also does not specify the requirement to have a fire extinguisher, but recommends to follow the SCCA GCRs which also don't say it is mandatory. If there isn't a mandatory rule to have a fire extinguisher in the vehicle, we would like the rule changed to say "recommended". Every turn station as well as the safety vehicle are equipped with fire extinguishers.

- CHANGE 18) It is **mandatory** that a fire extinguisher with a minimum 5BC rating and gauge be mounted securely in the car with a metal strap. (NOTE: fire extinguishers must be certified upon purchase and re-certified every two years and/or after each use.)
