Old Business: Has there been any races under the new regulations for the new regulations for cars newer than 1997 running wheel to wheel, rubber to ice without role cages. Nobody has any first hand information on these events.

Jonathon - would like to get more information from Clay regarding side by sides

Clay – Well received by city, part of winter festival in town, received a grant from city

Geoff – suggests using a highest average speed similar to way rally does

Clay – His proposal includes that. He's been researching how things are done by ice racers in the USA for unlimited studs. Their events are held at Charley Lake in Fort St John. They have a boat ramp you can drive your cars down to get onto the ice.
