Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order: 7:02 PM. Quorum requirement of 10% of current Vintage Licensees (38) was met.
2. Approval of minutes of previous general meeting - February 20, 2025 – Motion Aaron/Paul, carried
3. Old business from previous general meeting - none
4. New Business:
 - Vintage Discipline rule change proposals:
 - i. RCP-2025-4420 – Competitor Safety Equipment – Replace existing section with a reference to the relevant GCRs - Motion carried unanimously
 - ii. RCP-2025-4421 – Delete reference to “Improved Production Roll Cage” because this item does not exist – Motion carried unanimously
 - iii. RCP-2025-4538 - Amend the references to specific age categories for medical forms so that they remain consistent with those of the Race Discipline – Motion carried unanimously
 - Discipline Budget for 2026
 - i. Vintage Race permit set at \$200 – no change from 2025
 - ii. Vintage Race license fee set at \$40 – no change from 2025
 - iii. Sponsorships set at \$250 – reduced from \$500 in 2025
 - iv. Advertising set at \$1,500 – no change from 2025
 - v. Travel Tow Fund set at \$500 – no change from 2025

The annual revenue was projected at \$1,800 consisting of 40 licences at \$40 and one permit at \$200. The resulting approved budget projects a deficit of \$450 for the year. Pam indicated that the Discipline has sufficient funds to accommodate this but that the budget will need careful review for 2027.

5. Other Business:
 - Tracey thanked the Discipline on behalf of WIM for their donation in 2025 and gave a short presentation on WIM’s activities last season and their plans for 2026. The attendees expressed their appreciation for all of the excellent promotional work that WIM continues to do.

- There was a general discussion on the need to rationalize the Vintage Regulations with respect to the GCRs and the VRCBC's annual Eligibility Rules. Stanton stated he planned to work on this during the upcoming year and Brett volunteered to assist.
6. Annual CACC Vintage Contributor of the Year Award: Mike Bailey agreed to prepare an email survey for nominations for this award. Doug Floer agreed to distribute it to the current Discipline members with replies directly to Stanton, who would compile the results and select the winner.
 7. Election of Discipline Director – Stan offered to continue for 2026. No one else volunteered to stand or was nominated. Stan was elected by acclamation. Stanton asked Aaron to be available as a backup if required and he agreed.
 8. Motion to adjourn
